High Tech Thursdays

High Tech Thursdays events are informal networking events where CXO Connect members get together, have a beer, and create / build personal relationships.

High Tech Thursdays are scheduled quarterly, on a Thursday, from 5-7pm.

CXO Connect Spotlight *(coming soon)*

The CXO Connect Spotlight is a “three questions / five minutes format” video interview featuring a prominent CXO Connect member. CXO Connect Spotlights are featured on the CXO Connect web site. During the interview, the member is asked three questions:

- Defining Moment – Share your inspiration, motivation, a defining moment in your life.
- The Future – Talk about what you would like to accomplish, how you would like to be remembered.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Who benefits from CXO Connect?

A. The members. CXO Connect is a group established for the benefit of the members.

Q. How much does it cost?

A. For qualified individuals, everything is basically free. Time and money are both very precious commodities. We work hard to keep our events focused (to save time) and free (to save money).

Q. I'm too busy running my business. Why should I participate?

One of the goals of CXO Connect is to help you realize that building a network of peers, mentors, advisors, and other professionals is important to your success and the success of your business.

Q. I'm interested in becoming a member. How can I join?

A. Not everyone can (or should) be a member. To become a member, you must be nominated by an existing member.

Q. What's the difference between CXO Connect and other networking groups?

A. Focus and values. CXO Connect membership is limited to senior level executives, founders, and financiers involved with high technology companies. CXO Connect members are driven by the desire to contribute and help others in the high technology.

Q. I want to attend a High Tech Thursdays event. How can I get invited?

A. To receive event invitations, sign up for a web site login account. An invitation does not mean you should attend CXO Connect events. To attend, you must be a Founder, Senior Executive, or Financier of a company actively involved with the Colorado High-Technology Community.

Q. CXO Connect allows sponsors, doesn't that affect the quality of the group / event?

A. Time and money are important resources. Every CXO Connect event is structured to help members efficiently use their time. Sponsors make it possible to reduce / eliminate the cost to attend the events.

Q. What are the benefits of sponsoring an event?

A. Visibility to CXO Connect members.

Q. What are the sponsorship opportunities?

A. Each event has an Event Host and Event Sponsor. The Event Host provides the facilities for the event. This is the host's chance to "showcase" their company. The Event Sponsor pays for the event.

Q. Who is Red Rake and what is its relationship to CXO Connect?

A. Red Rake owns all intellectual property and assets associated with CXO Connect. Red Rake, LLC manages the cxoconnect.com website and all CXO Connect events.

Q. How are you going to keep your events focused?

A. Using RSVP's we can closely watch the list of attendees. The events are for our members. Our target is to limit attendance of service providers to <10%. With that said, it's important to remember that some individuals wear more than one hat. While they may be a service provider, they may also have a tremendous desire to contribute to the high technology community. This includes CXO Connect Advisor Members (among others). Because of this, these attendees are typically not included in the 10% limit.
